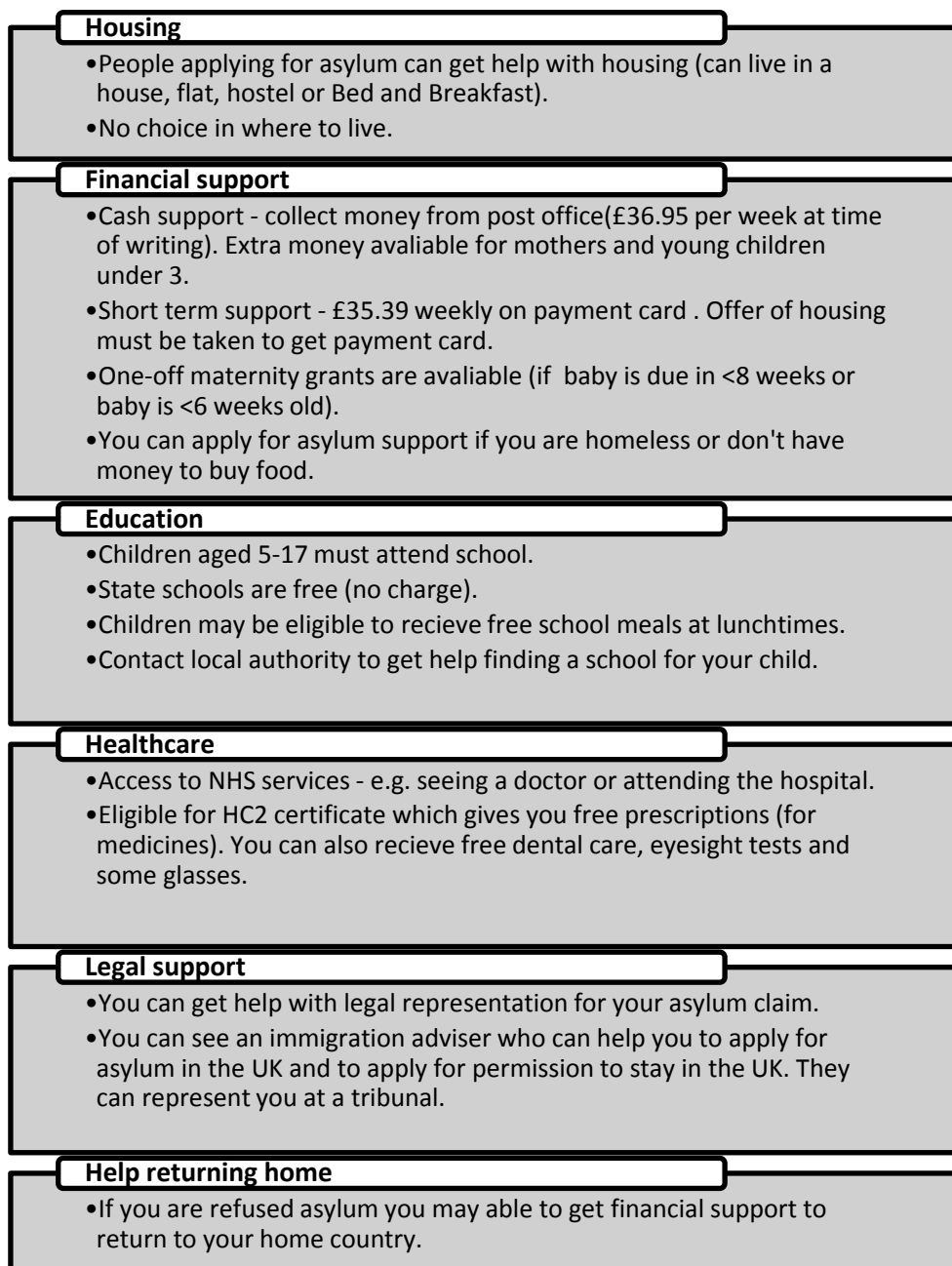


Figure 1: Financial and practical support available for those seeking asylum in the UK
